**STATUS OF MISSION INDRADHANUSH IN KARNATAKA**

**3129:SHRI NARAYANA KORAGAPPA**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of vaccinated, partially vaccinated, completely unvaccinated under Mission Indradhanush (MI) in Karnataka, district-wise with coverage percentage and numbers as on date;
- (b) the number of high focus districts under MI in Karnataka and their coverage as on date; and
- (c) the details on more than 90 per cent and 100 per cent immunization coverage achieved districts in Karnataka?

(a) and (b) Mission Indradhanush campaign is conducted to identify and vaccinate partially vaccinated and unvaccinated children and pregnant women with the missed vaccine doses in the pockets of low immunization coverage. The districts are identified based on the data of Immunization coverage, Vaccine Preventable Diseases (VPD) surveillance and Demographic factors. Based on the criteria in the year 2022, 10 districts were identified to carry out the Mission Indradhanush 4.0. The details of number and percentage of children and pregnant women vaccinated with missed/due doses of vaccines under Mission Indradhanush 4.0 in Karnataka, district wise is placed in Annexure 1.

(c) 21 districts of Karnataka have achieved Full Immunization Coverage (FIC) of >90%, out of which 13 districts have achieved 100% FIC as per Health Management Information System (HMIS) for the period April 2022 to December 2022 as on 20<sup>th</sup> January 2023. The details of the districts with more than 90 per cent and 100 per cent Full Immunization Coverage in Karnataka are placed at Annexure 2.
