- (d) whether Government has set any deadline for completion of the project and if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): As part of AIIMS Phase-II project in Jhajjar, Haryana, National Cancer Institute was set up at an approved cost of Rs.2035 crores and the details of the funds allocated in each of the last five years for continuing the project are as under:

2021-22	263.40
