STATUS OF BENEFICIARIES UNDER UIP

3145:SHRI K.R. SURESH REDDY:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of beneficiaries under the Universal Immunisation Programme (UIP) State-wise;
- (b) whether measures being taken to create awareness regarding the benefits of vaccines;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the expenditure incurred for implementing UIP, including the amount incurred on awareness programmes Year-wise?

(a) Under Universal Immunization Programme (UIP), vaccines are administered to around 2.6 crore children and 2.9 crore pregnant women annually. The estimated number of beneficiaries including infants and pregnant women for the year 2022-2023, State/UT wise is placed at Annexure I.

(b) and (c) The measures taken by the Government to create awareness regarding benefit of vaccines includes awareness generation through a 360° approach using social media, mid media and Inter Personal Communication (IPC) and social mobilization among the community by front line health workers like Auxiliary Nurse Midwife (ANM) and Accredited Social Health Activists (ASHAs) and Anganwadi Workers (AWWs).

(d) The expenditure incurred by States/UTs for implementation of Universal Immunization Programme (UIP) includes the expenditure incurred for awareness programmes. The expenditure incurred for implementation of UIP is placed at Annexure II.
