HEALTH INFRASTRUCTURE IN THE COUNTRY

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact the there is a shortage of Primary Health Clinics (PMCs) in many districts of the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether Government has any data on the number of Primary Health Clinics;
- (d) the details of Government hospitals and medical colleges established by Government in the last five years, State wise, district wise and year wise; and
- (e) the number of doctors currently working at Primary Health Clinics and Government hospitals?

(a) to (d) : As per the norms under Indian Public Health Standards(IPHS) 2022, a PHC in rural area can be established for a population of 30,000 in plains and 20,000 in hilly and tribal areas. Urban PHCs can be established at a population of 50,000.

Rural Health Statistics (RHS) is an annual publication, based on Health care administrative data reported by States/UTs. As per RHS 2021-22, State/UT-wise details of PHCs may be seen at the following link of RHS 2021-22:

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare provides technical and financial support to the States/UTs to strengthen the public healthcare system, based on the proposals received in the form of Programme Implementation Plans (PIPs) under National Health Mission. Government of India provides approval for the proposal in the form of Record of Proceedings (RoPs) as per norms & available resources.

Under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for 'Establishment of new Medical Colleges attached with existing district/referral hospitals', a total of 157 medical colleges have been sanctioned in three phases with fund sharing between the Centre and State Governments in the ratio of 90:10 for North eastern and Special Category States and 60:40 for others. Out of these, 104 colleges have been approved in last five years i.e. from 2017-18 to 2021-22. Details are at **Annexure-I**.

Further, under PMSSY Nine new AIIMS for establishment and two Government Medical Colleges/Institutions (GMCIs) for upgradation have been approved during last 5 years, details are at **Annexure-II**.

Progress over the year, in respect of details of Sub Divisional Hospitals, District Hospitals and Medical Colleges established by state Government in the last five years, State wise, district wise and year wise can be accessed through comparing RHS 2021-22 from 2016-17.
