Access to computers and internet connection in Schools

3210 Smt. Vandana Chavan:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government has conducted a survey to check the proportion of schools across the country that have access to computers and functional internet connection;

(b) if so, the details of the survey and the number and proportion of such schools; and

(c) whether such proportion of schools are less in number and if so, the steps being taken to increase the access of computers and internet connection amongst schools?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SMT. ANNPURNA DEVI)

(a) to (c) Education is in the concurrent list of the Constitution and majority of the schools are under the domain of respective State and UT Governments. The Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Samagra Shiksha is implemented in partnership with all the States and UTs and financial assistance is provided to all States and UTs for various components including ICT infrastructure in schools. Under Samagra Shiksha, ICT component envisages covering all Government and Aided schools from classes VI to XII and Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs), subject to the availability of budgetary provision.

For ICT component onetime non-recurring grant upto Rs 6.40 lakh per school and a recurring grant of upto Rs. 2.40 lakh per school per annum for a period of 5 years is provided. For the financial year 2022-23, Rs. 988.2 crore has been approved.

ICT component covers Government and Aided Schools having classes from VI to XII which will enable use of ICT resources from younger grades. ICT Labs are approved in 120614 schools. The State/UT wise details of ICT Labs approved at **Annexure-I**. BSNL has informed that the Department of Telecom has given responsibility to BSNL to improve the rural connectivity using Bharat Net Assets and BSNL is taking steps for further extending its services across one lakh forty thousand plus Gram Panchayats in the country. On 11.07.2022, Department of School Education & Literacy has issued an advisory to all the States and UTs to enter into an MoU/ Agreement with BSNL and provide FTTH Internet connection to all the Government Schools which have computing devices.
