(a) to (d):All 36 States/Union Territories have launched/launching their foundational literacy and numeracy mission that is National Initiative for Proficiency in Reading with Understanding and Numeracy(NIPUN-Bharat) Mission. The mission is being run in all the States and UTs.

A National Conference on Initiatives in Foundational Learning: Voices from the Ground (NCIFLVG) for all the states and UTs was organized in July 2022 to share their innovations and best practices under NIPUN Bharat Mission. A report of the same has been prepared and released. Apart from that Ministry of Education has also shared a document "Community Engagement in Foundational Learning: Initiatives and Studies Across Countries". This document includes best practices from States and UTs also to maximize parent and community engagement.
