(b) if so, the districts of Himachal Pradesh in which the Resource Centre is proposed to be

set up; and

(c) the funds provisioned to be allocated for the Resource Centre, the details thereof,

district-wise?

(a) to (c): Under revamped RGSA schemes, the provision for setting up District Panchayat

Resource Center (DPRC) in the States/UTs of the Country on a limited scale. RGSA is a

demand-driven scheme, States/UTs submits Annual Action Plan of the respective year for

consideration and approval to the Ministry. During the FY 2022-23, no proposal for set up of

any new DPRC has been received from the State of Himachal Pradesh in the Annual Action

Plan of the revamped RGSA Scheme. Through Ministry's support, 5 DPRCs are functional in

the State.
