**CONSTRUCTION WORK ON NH-39 SIDHI-SINGRAULI SECTION**

3279. SHRI AJAY PRATAP SINGH:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of construction work completed on four laning of NH-39 Sidhi-Singrauli, in kilometers;
- (b) the work in kilometers that is yet to be completed in this section; and
- (c) the number of bridges and culverts that are incomplete in this section, the reasons therefor and by when the same will be completed?

(a) to (c) Out of total project length of 105 km of four laning of National Highway (NH) -39 from Sidhi to Singrauli in Madhya Pradesh, 38 km has been completed upto Dense Bituminous Macadam (DBM) level and balance including structures are at construction stage. Earlier, the project was taken up for development on Build Operate and Transfer (BOT) mode. After termination of BOT project, tenders have been invited for balance work on Engineering Procurement and Construction (EPC) mode of execution. The likely date of completion of the project is December, 2023.
