PRADHAN MANTRI AWAAS YOJANA (GRAMIN) IN WEST BENGAL

3306 MS. DOLA SEN:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of projects started and completed in the State of West Bengal since the inception of Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana (Gramin), district-wise details thereof;
- (b) the details of the total amount of funds allocated and disbursed for the completion of the projects under the scheme;
- (c) whether Government has ascertained any targets for the upcoming fiscal under the scheme; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, reasons therefor?

ANSWER

- (a) The Ministry of Rural Development is implementing Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G) with effect from 1st April, 2016 to achieve the objective of “Housing for All” in rural areas with the overall target of construction of 2.95 crore pucca houses with basic amenities by 31st March, 2024. The Ministry allocates the targets under PMAY-G by considering the State as one unit and the district-wise targets are allocated by the State themselves. The district-wise details of targets fixed by the State, houses sanctioned & completed in the State of West Bengal under PMAY-G since inception as on 23.03.2023 is given in **Annexure**.
- (b) The Central share under PMAY-G is released directly to the State/Union Territory (UT), considering the State/UT as a unit, on the basis of balance targets, liabilities and unspent balance available. Further, release of these funds to beneficiaries in various districts is done by the respective State/UT. The Financial Year wise details of Central Share released by the Ministry and fund utilized by the State of West Bengal for release of installments of assistance under PMAY-G is given as under:

(c) & (d) The Ministry has allocated targets of 2.95 crore houses to the States/Union Territories (UTs) and a total of 2.86 crore houses have been sanctioned to beneficiaries and 2.22 crore houses completed. In so far in as the State of West Bengal is concerned, the State has been allocated a target of 46.19 lakh houses against which, sanctions have been given to 45.70 lakh beneficiaries and 33.90 lakh houses have been completed as on 23.03.2023.
