- (a): Yes Sir, Government of India plans to set-up 22 new Software Technology Parks of India (STPI) centres across the country.
- (b): State-wise list of new approved STPI centres is at **Annexure-I.**
- (c) and (d): Currently, there is no such proposal to set-up new STPI centre in Andhra Pradesh. However, four STPI centres are already operational in Andhra Pradeshat Kakinada, Tirupati, Vijayawada and Visakhapatnam.
