(a) Yes, Sir. Ministry of Railways has taken steps to install CCTV camera at Doorway area of railway coaches from security point of view.

(b) & (c) More than 6600 coaches are presently equipped with CCTV cameras. Further, it has been planned to provide CCTVs cameras in all passengers coaches in phased manner.
