AIRPORTS OPERATED BY PRIVATE COMPNIES

3542. SHRI SANDEEP KUMAR PATHAK

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) the number of airports handed over to private companies in the country during the last five years, details thereof, year-wise;**
- (b) the profit/loss details of all the airports of the country during the last five years and names of the operators for respective year, year-wise, the details of the total tax/fee etc. given by the operator company to Government from all these airports during the said period, year-wise; and**
- (c) details of all the agreements signed by the former and present private operator companies with Government for the operation of Delhi, Mumbai, Ahmedabad, Guwahati and Bengaluru Airports?**

ANSWER

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD))

a): During the last five years, Airports Authority of India (AAI) has leased out six of its airports namely, Ahmedabad in Gujarat (2020), Lucknow in Uttar Pradesh (2020), Mangaluru in Karnataka (2020), Jaipur in Rajasthan (2021), Guwahati in Assam (2021) and Thiruvananthapuram in Kerala (2021) for Operations, Management and Development under Public Private Partnership (PPP) for a period of 50 years.

b):A statement showing the annual profit/loss of 124 airports run by AAI, for last 5 years (FY 2017-18 to FY 2021-22) is enclosed at Annexure-A.

During the last five years i.e. from 2017-18 to 2021-22, AAI has received revenues of approximately Rs. 5500 crore from the private partner of Delhi Airport and Rs. 5174 crore from Mumbai Airport. AAI has also received Rs. 896 crore from the 6 airports i.e Ahmedabad, Mangaluru, Lucknow, Guwahati, Jaipur and Thiruvananthapuram as Per Passenger Fee (PPF) since handing over of the airport till February, 2023. AAI has also received an amount of approximately Rs.2349 crore from the Private Partners of six airports in the form of upfront fee towards the capital expenditure incurred by AAI at these airports.

In addition, Gol also receives 4% of the Gross Revenue as Concession Fee from Operators of Bangalore and Hyderabad Airports. So far, Gol has received an amount of approximately Rs. 620 crore as Concession Fee from these airport operators.
