## SETTING UP OF AIRPORT TERMINAL AT BHAVNAGAR, GUJARAT

- (a) how old is the airport terminal of Bhavnagar, Gujarat;
- (b) when was the demand to renovate this terminal sent by local authority; and
- (c) the measures taken thereon?

### **ANSWER**

- (a): The Bhavnagar Terminal Building was built in 1985.
- (b) & (c): No such proposal for a new airport terminal has been received. However, upgradation/ modernisation of airports is a continuous process and is undertaken by Airports Authority of India (AAI) and other Airport Operators from time to time depending on the availability of land, commercial viability, socio-economic considerations, traffic demand / willingness of airlines to operate to/from such airports.
