## Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the waste treatment plant at Brahmapuram, Kochi has been set up in compliance with the Solid Waste Management Rules;
- (b) whether the recent fire outbreak at Brahmapuram plant which lasted for two weeks is an aftermath of the violation of the rules;
- (c) whether Government will conduct an enquiry regarding the fire outbreak at Brahmapuram; and
- (d) whether Government will adopt measures to ensure strict compliance of the rules for avoiding such mishaps in future?

## ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

- (a):The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) has notified Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 as per which it is the responsibility of State Governments/Union Territory (UT) Administrations to enforcecompliance of its provisions.
- (b) to (d): As informed by MoEFCC, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) officials observed violation of SWM Rules, 2016 and issued comprehensive directions under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 by the CPCB on 24<sup>th</sup> March, 2023 to Kerala State Pollution Board (KSPB) regarding fire accident at solid waste dumpsite at Brahampuram, Kochi, Kerala
