STATUS OF MPLADS

3673. SHRI RAJMANI PATEL:

Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of budget allocated in the account of Members of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme (MPLADS) from April 2018 to March 2023;
- (b) the number of works recommended by the questioner for which order has been passed by Planning Department, Rewa, the details thereof including date and amount;
- (c) the number of works completed; and
- (d) the number of incomplete works and the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

- (a) Funds released under MPLADS to MPs since 2018 is as per Annexure-I.
- (b) to (d). During the period from April, 2018 to March, 2023, funds to the tune of Rs. 14.5 crore have been released to the MPLADS Account of Sh. Rajmani Patel, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Rajya Sabha. Under the MPLAD Scheme, Hon'ble MPs send their recommendations of development works directly to their respective Nodal District Authorities and the same are implemented by the District Authorities in accordance with the administrative, financial and technical rules of the concerned State/UT Governments and in accordance with the Guidelines on MPLADS. As per the information furnished by the Govt. of Madhya Pradesh, a total of 549 works have been recommended by Sh. Rajmani Patel, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Rajya Sabha during the aforesaid period, out of which 539 works of Rs.17.06 crore have been sanctioned. Out of these, 277 works have been completed and 262 works are in progress.
