- (a) how many Assistant Professors in Delhi university who were working against vacancies, on ad-hoc basis, are not appointed by the selection Committees; and
- (b) how many of them had a teaching experience of more than five years?

ANSWER

(a) and (b) The recruitment in University of Delhi is a continuous process. The recruitment is made from open vacancies and ad-hoc employees working in the University are also eligible for recruitment. University of Delhi has informed that in the departments of the University twelve teachers working on ad-hoc basis have not been appointed and all of them had teaching experience of more than five years.
