**Completion of works of IIT Tirupati**

**3707 Shri V. Vijayasai Reddy:**

Will the Minister of **Education** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that IITs got an amount of Rs. 9,661 crores for 2023-24;
- (b) if so, details of amount that IIT, Tirupati got for 2023-24;
- (c) how the above amount is going to be utilized in 2023-24; and
- (d) by when all the works of IIT, Tirupati, are going to be completed?

**ANSWER**

(DR. SUBHAS SARKAR)

(a): For the financial year 2023-24, an amount of Rs. 9361.50 cr. has been allocated for Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs).

(b): For financial year 2023-24, IIT Tirupati has requested for an allocation of Rs. 407.49 cr. The actual allocation to be made to IIT Tirupati is under process.

(c): The amount of Rs. 9361.50 cr. shall be utilized for meeting the recurring and non-recurring expenses of IITs such as salary, pension, scholarships, wages of contractual staff, purchase of small equipment, library books, HEFA principle/ interest repayments, etc.

(d): The physical works of IIT Tirupati are scheduled to be completed by 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2023, while handing over and commissioning activities are scheduled to be completed by 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2023.
