- (b) the number of Indian companies and multi-national companies which have invested during this period and in how many industries, the details thereof, year-wise?

(a): As per the information provided by the Government of Jammu and Kashmir, a total of 185 persons from outside the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir have bought land in the UT during the years 2020, 2021 and 2022, the details of which are as under:

Further, as per the information provided by the Union Territory of Ladakh, no land has been bought by persons from outside the UT during the last three years.
