(a) & (b) The re-awarded balance work of Rehabilitation and Upgradation of Sidhi-Singrauli from

km 82.400 to km 187.993 of NH 39 in the State of Madhya Pradesh is running behind schedule.

Out of total project length of 105 km, four laning in 38 km up to Dense Bituminous Macadam

(DBM) level have been completed. The aforesaid work was awarded to the Contractor through

open competitive bidding on e-procurement portal which is in public domain. The work is likely

be completed by December 2023.
