BUDGETARY ALLOCATION FOR RURAL DEVELOPMENT SCHEMES IN TAMIL NADU

Will the Minister of Rural Development be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has increased budgetary allocation to the Centrally sponsored rural development schemes MGNREGA, PMAY(G), DAY-NRLM, PMGSY, NSAP, DDUGKY,SAGY, SPMRM, Mission ANTYODAYA implemented in Tamil Nadu and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the funds allocated in the last five years, year-wise, Scheme-wise; and
- (c) the total number of beneficiaries got support from the Rural Livelihood programs in Tamil Nadu in the last five years?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a) & (b) Ministry of Rural Development is implementing a number of schemes for rural areas of the country including Tamil Nadu viz., Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS), Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana – Gramin (PMAY-G), Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana – National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM), Deen Dayal Upadhayay – Gramin Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY), Rural Self Employment and Training Institutes (RSETIs), National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP), Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission (SPMRM) to bring about overall development of rural areas. These schemes have been framed to deliver basic amenities and facilities like providing pucca house, all weather road connectivity, strengthening of livelihood opportunities, providing minimum guaranteed rural employment, promoting self-employment, skilling of rural youths in various useful trades and entrepreneurship qualities, infrastructure development and provision of social assistance.

The Scheme-wise funds allocated/ released to the State of Tamil Nadu under various rural development schemes during last five years are as under:

Under Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY), implementation of activities are done in GPs which are identified by the Hon'ble Members of Parliament and works are undertaken through convergence with existing central and state government schemes. There is no separate fund under SAGY.

Mission Antyodaya (MA) Survey is a convergence and accountability framework aiming to bring optimum use and management of resources allocated by 27 Ministries/ Department of the Government of India under various programmes for the development of rural areas, without allocation of budget of its own.
