TRAINING UNDER DDU-GKY TO THE YOUTHS OF ANDHRA PRADESH

3779. SHRI KANAKAMEDALA RAVINDRA KUMAR:

Will the Minister of Rural Development be pleased to state:

- (a) details of training that is being provided to youths of Andhra Pradesh under Deen Dayal Upadhyayay Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY);
- (b) whether any special educational/training curriculum has been prepared for them in this connection;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether youths who are undergoing this training are being provided stipend/scholarship/financial assistance during the training period; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

- (a) to (c) The training being imparted to the youths under DDU-GKY is based on the qualification packs approved by National Skills Qualification Committee. The training consists of theory, practical and on-the job training (OJT) imparted in domain skills, computer skills, soft skills and English skills. The details of the trades under which training is being provided to youths of Andhra Pradesh are given as **Annexure-I**.
- (d) & (e) DDU-GKY guidelines provide for the following financial benefit to the candidate other than Training Cost & Assessment Cost: 1. Boarding & Lodging for Residential Trainees 2. Post Placement Support, 3.Uniform, 4. Food & Transport for Non Residential Trainees, 5. Travel Support, 6. Retention Support, 7.Career Progression Support 8. Counselling support including medical checkups for candidates placed in foreign countries 9. Mobile top-up support @ Rs. 50 per month for a period of 12 months is also permissible within the Scheme for mobile tracking of the trainee. Details are provided in **Annexure-II**.
