PERSON DAYS GENERATED AND FUND UTILISATION UNDER MGNREG SCHEME

3789. SHRI PRABHAKAR REDDY VEMIREDDY:

Will the Minister of Rural Development be pleased to state:

- (a) details of person days projected by States under MGNREGS for 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24, year-wise and State-wise;
- (b) details of person days utilized by States under MGNREGS for above years, year-wise and State-wise, except 2023-24;
- (c) whether it is a fact that many States have utilized less than what they have projected;
- (d) if so, reasons therefor and efforts being made by the Ministry to convince States to achieve projected target set by them; and
- (e) efforts being made to increase days of employment from the present 42 days per year?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a) to (e) Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS) is a demand driven wage employment Scheme.

As per the provision of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (Mahatma Gandhi NREGA), 2005, States/UTs are requested by the Central Government to send a detailed proposal for the Labour Budget of the upcoming financial year after following due process. The proposal received from States/UTs is considered by the Empowered Committee under the chairpersonship of Secretary, Department of Rural Development, Government of India in the month of February/March, which decides the projected Labour Budget of upcoming financial year in consultation with State Government. This "agreed to" Labour Budget is an indicative number for better planning so that works can be provided against demand on time. However, the State may always come up with a proposal for the revision of the Labour Budget, at any point of time of the financial year, if the performance of the State exceeds the "agreed to" Labour Budget.

State/UT-wise details of employment provided (in person-days generated) under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS in the last three financial years 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23 are given at **Annexure-I.**

State/UT-wise details of projected persondays (Approved Labour Budget) under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS for the financial year 2023-24 are given at **Annexure-II.**

To generate awareness about the provisions of the Scheme and to provide adequate employment opportunities to rural households under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS, all States/UTs have been requested to (i) initiate appropriate Information Education and Communication (IEC) campaigns including wall paintings for the wide dissemination of the provisions of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (Mahatma Gandhi NREGA), 2005 (ii) expand scope and coverage of demand registration system to ensure that demand for work under Mahatma Gandhi NREGA does not go unregistered, (iii) prepare plans in a participatory mode and approve them in the Gram Sabha. (iv) Organization of 'Rozgar Diwas'.
