Will the Minister of *Housing and Urban Affairs* be pleased to state:

- (a) the status of Smart Cities Mission (SCM) in Bihar;
- (b) the details of projects undertaken for the SCM in Bihar;
- (c) the details of funds allocated to the State of Bihar under the SCM in the last three years;
- (d) whether there has been a delay in the implementation of SCM in Patna; and
- (e) if so, the reasons therefor along with measures taken by Government?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

(a) to (e) : Government of India launched Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June 2015. 100 Smart Cities have been selected through 4 rounds of competition from January 2016 to June 2018. The cities of Bhagalpur, Biharsharif, Muzaffarpur & Patna have been selected for development as Smart Cities in Bihar. The status of projects and funds released by the Central Government for Smart Cities in Bihar are given below: -
