#### **3847. Dr. V. SIVADASAN:**

### Will the MINISTER OF CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the Government is providing or has provided any funds to the temple trusts in the country;
- (b) if so, the funds allocated to various temple trusts in the country since 2018, the temple trustwise, year wise and scheme-wise details thereof;
- (c) Whether there has been any directive or conditionality about the need to promote Government programmes for the release of fund; and
- (d) The funds allocated to worshipping centres of religious minorities since 2018, the trust-wise, year-wise and scheme-wise details thereof?

### **ANSWER**

- (a) Yes Sir, the Ministry of Culture administers two schemes by the name of 'Financial Assistance for Allied Cultural Activities' and 'Seva Bhoj Yojana' under which financial assistance is provided to various religious organizations including Temple Trusts.
- (b) 'Financial Assistance for Allied Cultural Activities' is sub-component of 'Scheme of Financial Assistance for Creation of Cultural Infrastructure'. Therefore, no separate budgetary allocation is made under this Scheme component. However, the details of funds released under this scheme component is at Annexure-I. The budgetary allocation and funds released under Seva Bhoj Yojana is at Annexure-II.
- (c) Ministry of Culture has issued guidelines under the above mentioned two schemes for release of funds to meet and promote the objectives of these schemes. The eligibility criteria for release of funds under these two schemes is at Annexure-III.

(d) There is no provision under the above mentioned two schemes for separate allocation of funds to religious minorities. However, under 'Seva Bhoj Yojana', funds have been released to Sikh Gurudwara Parbandhak Committee (SGPC) as per the following details:-

## Eligibility Criteria for release of funds

(i) <u>Financial Assistance for Allied Cultural Activities</u>:- Under the Scheme of Allied Cultural Activities, financial assistance is provided to all 'not-for-profit' organizations who are engaged at least for past three years in presenting the spectacle for allied cultural activities to give first hand experience of live performances on regular basis and during festivals in open/closed areas/spaces where large numbers of tourists/visitors come regularly and during major events/festivals the number of visitors swells to lakhs.

The organization is registered as a society under the Registration of Societies Act (XXI of 1860) or similar Acts, or as a Trust or as a Not-for-Profit Company, at least for a period of three years; and

The applicant organization will submit a recommendation letter in the prescribed format (Annexure-I) from the District Authority (District Magistrate/District Collector/Deputy Commissioner) or State Governments/Union Territories/District Authorities in this regard.

(ii) <u>Seva Bhoj Yojana</u>:- Under the Scheme of Seva Bhoj Yojana financial assistance is provided to in the form of reimbursement of CGST and Central Government's share of IGST paid by charitable/religious institutions like Gurudwaras, Temples, Dharmik Ashram, Mosques, Dargah, Church, Math, Monasteries etc.on purchase of specific raw food items viz. (i) Ghee (ii) Edible Oil (iii) Sugar/Burra/Jaggery (iv) Rice (v) Atta/Maida/Rava/Flour and (vi) Pulses for serving free food to public / devotees is re-imbrued.

These Charitable/Religious Institutions are required to distribute free food in the form of 'prasad', 'langar'/bhandara (community kitchen) to at least 5000 persons in a calendar month for at least past 3 years.
