IMPLEMENTATION OF AMRUT IN ANDHRA PRADESH

NO. 385. SHRI KANAKAMEDALA RAVINDRA KUMAR:

Will the Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the projects that are being undertaken in the State of Andhra Pradesh under AMRUT;
- (b) the details of the committed central assistance for these projects;
- (c) the details of the contribution of the State of Andhra Pradesh and urban local bodies to these projects;
- (d) the details of the work that have been completed; and
- (e) the details of the work that are still continuing?

ANSWER

(a): The Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) was launched on 25 June 2015 in 500 cities in all the States/UTs in the country. The Mission focuses on development of basic infrastructure in the selected cities/towns in the sectors of water supply; sewerage and septage management; storm water drainage; green spaces and parks; and non-motorized urban transport.

Under AMRUT Mission, State of Andhra Pradesh has taken up 226 projects worth ₹3,333.76 crore.

(b)& (c): The committed Central Assistance (CA) for the State of Andhra Pradesh for implementation of the projects under AMRUT is ₹1,056.62 crore. Beyond CA, the remaining cost of projects shall be borne by the State / ULBs.

(d)& (e): Under AMRUT Mission, State of Andhra Pradesh has taken up 226 projects worth ₹3,333.76 crore of which, 105 projects worth ₹801.10 crore have already been completed and 121 projects worth ₹2,532.66 crore are under progress.

Further, 4.02 lakh water tap connections have been provided so far under AMRUT & in convergence with other schemes against targeted 7.29 lakh connections & 3.96 lakh sewer connections/household coverage under septage management have been provided against targeted 1.31 lakh connections. 2,494 KM of water supply network & 139 KM of sewer network has been laid. Through park projects, 136-acre green area has been developed & 73-acre area under greening is in progress.
