**INSURANCE COVER TO UNORGANISED WORKERS REGISTERED ON  
E-SHRAM PORTAL**

**3936. SHRI V. VIJAYASAI REDDY:**

**Will the Minister of Labour and Employment be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether it is a fact that more than 10.5 crore unorganized workers have been registered on e-SHRAM portal;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise, with a particular reference to the State of Andhra Pradesh;**
- (c) whether it is also a fact that accidental insurance coverage of ₹ 2 lakh has been given to these workers free of cost for the first year;**
- (d) whether Government would consider extending one year of life insurance free of cost in view of the pandemic; and**
- (e) the manner in which Government propagates that it is giving insurance benefit to registered unorganized sector workers?**

**(a) to (e): As on 27th March 2023, over 28.78 crore unorganised workers have registered on eShram portal. State/ UT wise details of registration on eShram portal including Andhra Pradesh are annexed.**

**The scheme envisage to provide accidental insurance coverage of ₹ 2 lakh free of cost for a year to all eligible registered unorganised workers. Further, there is no proposal under consideration for extending insurance coverage.**

**In order to propagate eShram and its benefits, Ministry has taken several steps which include regular social media releases, regular camps and drives, IEC (Information, Education, and Communication) funds to States/ UTs for promotion of eShram, etc.**
