E-SHRAM PORTAL FOR UNORGANIZED SECTOR WORKERS

3945. # DR. KIRODI LAL MEENA:

Will the Minister of Labour and Employment be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has recently launched a national database e-Shram portal with a unique Universal Account Number for the overall welfare of unorganized sector workers in the country, if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) the number of workers registered on the e-Shram portal so far after its launch, State- wise; and**
- (c) whether Government's pension scheme and any life insurance scheme are proposed to be the initial schemes linked to this portal and if so, the details thereof?**

ANSWER

**MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT
(SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)**

(a) to (c): The eShram portal was launched on 26th August 2021 for creation of a comprehensive National Database of Unorganised Workers. After successful registration, a unique Universal Account Number (UAN) is issued to the eShram registrant. As on 27th March 2023, over 28.78 crore unorganised workers have been registered on eShram portal. State/ UT wise details of registration on eShram portal are annexed.

eShram has been integrated with Pradhan Mantri Shram-Yogi Maandhan (PMSYM) scheme. PMSYM is a voluntary and contributory pension scheme for unorganised sector workers who are aged between 18-40 years. After attaining the age of 60 years, beneficiaries will be eligible for a pension of Rs. 3,000/- per month under the scheme. eShram registrants can seamlessly get enrolled under the PMSYM scheme through eShram using their UAN number.
