TOTAL SANCTIONED STRENGTH OF INDIAN ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICE

3964 SHRI SUSHIL KUMAR MODI:

Will the **PRIME MINISTER** be pleased to state:

- (a) total sanctioned strength of Indian Administrative Service (IAS) officers vis-a-vis the total in-person strength at present, cadre-wise, State-wise;
- (b) total vacancies in direct recruitment posts and promotion posts, cadre-wise, State-wise;
- (c) pending promotion quota IAS vacancies at present, State-wise;
- (d) reasons for backlog in promotion quota vacancies in States;
- (e) whether Government intends to deliberate with State Governments over expediting the filling up of these vacancies, if so, details thereof;
- (f) details of recommendations submitted by Committee chaired by C. Chandramouli on IAS cadre strength; and
- (g) whether Government plans on increasing the number of direct IAS recruits through Civil Services Examination?

(a) to (c): State-wise/cadre-wise details are placed at Annexure-A.

(d): Backlog in promotion quota vacancies in States is due to non-submission of necessary proposals by the State Governments, resulting in non-holding of Selection Committee meetings by UPSC.

(e): The Central Government in consultation with UPSC on various occasions and at regular intervals, impresses upon the State Governments to expedite filling up of these vacancies.

(f): The said committee has recommended intake scenarios of Direct Recruit IAS officers on the basis of Civil Services Examination (CSE).

(g): No such proposal is presently under consideration.
