DESTINATION BASED SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME IN ODISHA

3982. SHRI SUJEET KUMAR:

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has taken note of abundant scope for creation of employment at tourist destinations and undertaken any initiative to exploit the resources;
- (b) if so, whether a Destination Based Skill Development Programme has been undertaken at a tourist site in the State of Odisha;
- (c) whether Government has any plan to identify new destinations in Odisha to be developed into tourist spots; and
- (d) if so, the details of the same?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

(a) & (b): Yes, Sir. Under the scheme of Capacity Building for Service Providers (CBSP), the Ministry of Tourism started the Destination Based Skill Development training programme at following 7 iconic sites in Financial Year 2019-20 to train, upgrade and sensitize the local people residing near these tourism sites and destinations:-

- i. Taj Mahal at Agra, Uttar Pradesh,
- ii. Humayun Tomb at Delhi,
- iii. Red Fort at Delhi,
- iv. Qutub Minar at Delhi,
- v. Mahabodhi Temple at Bihar,
- vi. Colva Beach at Goa,
- vii. Kaziranga at Assam.

This programme continued in the Financial Years 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23.

The details of number of Destinations covered in each of the year under the Destination Based Skill Development training programme is given in **Annexure-I.**

Ministry of Tourism conducts Incredible India Tourist Facilitator Certification (IITFC) programme in online mode. In these courses, basic, advance (heritage and adventure), spoken language and refresher courses are taught. So far, a total of 4438 candidates have been successfully certified.

(c) & (d): Development and identification of new tourism spots, is primarily the responsibility of the concerned State Government/Union Territory Administration and this is a continuous process. Ministry of Tourism, Government of India under its Schemes of Swadesh Darshan, PRASHAD and Assistance to Central Agencies, provides central financial assistance to State Governments/Union Territories/ Central Agencies for development of tourism related infrastructure and facilities to provide an enriching tourism experience to visitors including the State of Odisha. The projects under the Schemes are identified for development in consultation with State Governments/UT Administrations and are sanctioned subject to availability of funds, submission of suitable detailed project reports, adherence to scheme guidelines and utilization of funds released earlier.

Ministry of Tourism revamped its Swadesh Darshan scheme as Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD2.0) with the objective to develop sustainable and responsible destinations following a tourist and destination centric approach.
