PROMOTION OF TOURISM IN PUNJAB

3986 SHRI RAGHAV CHADHA:

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) the steps taken by the Ministry to promote border tourism in the State of Punjab;
- (b) the details of allocations made towards this end;
- (c) the steps taken by the Ministry to promote and facilitate tourism to pilgrimage destinations in the State; and
- (d) the details of implementation of National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD) in the State during the last four years?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

(a) to (d): The Ministry of Tourism promotes tourism in the country, including in the border areas, through its various Schemes. It provides financial assistance for development of tourism infrastructure in the country, including in the border states under its major Schemes of Swadesh Darshan and National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD), to State Governments / Union Territory Administrations/ Central Agencies. The financial assistance is given on the basis of submission of Detailed Project Reports, availability of funds and adherence to Scheme Guidelines. The Swadesh Darshan scheme has now been revamped as Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD 2.0) for development of sustainable and responsible tourist destinations. An amount of Rs.94.51 crore have been sanctioned for the development of the Heritage Circuit in Punjab in 2018-19, for the development of Anandpur Sahib – Fatehgarh Sahib – Chamkaur Sahib – Ferozpur – Amritsar – Khatkar Kalan – Kalanour – Patiala, under Swadesh Darshan Scheme.

Further, Ministry also promotes tourism in the state of Punjab in a holistic manner through various initiatives under its Schemes of "Domestic Promotion & Publicity including Hospitality" (DPPH) and "Overseas Promotion & Publicity (OPP)", including in the border States. It releases print, electronic, online and outdoor media campaigns in the domestic and international markets, under the "Incredible India" brand-line, to promote various tourism destinations and products of India. Financial assistance has been provided to the State Governments for the promotion of Fairs and Festivals. The list of the fairs and Festivals for which financial assistance has been given, is detailed at **Annexure**.

Further, Ministry of Tourism, has also sanctioned an amount of Rs.1312.00 lakh to Border Security Force (BSF) for the tourism related Infrastructural Development at Joint Check Post (JCP), Attari, Punjab in 2017-18.

The list of projects sanctioned to the State of Punjab under the PRASHAD Scheme is given at **Annexure**, out of which the project of "Development of Karuna Sagar Valmiki Sthal at Amritsar" has been completed.
