- 3) Sardar Patel Medical College, Bikaner
- 4) Jawahar Lal Nehru Medical College, Ajmer
- 5) Sawai Man Singh Medical College, Jaipur
- 6) RavindraNath Tagore Medical College, Udaipur
- 7) Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur
- 8) Government Medical College, Dungarpur

The proposals of Government of Rajasthan for setting up Multi Disciplinary Research Units in Government Medical Colleges at Bharatpur, Bhilwara, Churu, Jhalawar and Pali were also received and the respective Colleges advised to resubmit the proposals in accordance with the Guidelines for the Central Sector Scheme of setting up Multi Disciplinary Research Units.
