c) one of NEP's key focus areas was vocational education and training at the secondary level, whether this has been implemented; and

d) if so, the number of students who have opted for vocational education & training over last three years, State-wise?

(a) & (b): As per Unified District Information System for Education (UDISE+) the state wise number of students enrolled in class-1 (Government+ Government Aided Schools) during the last three years is at Annexure-I.

(c) & (d): The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 emphasises on imparting vocational education through integration and mainstreaming of vocational education with general education.

The Department of School Education and Literacy is implementing the initiative of Vocational Education under the umbrella of the Integrated Centrally Sponsored Scheme 'Samagra Shiksha'. The scheme aims at integrating Vocational Education with general academic education in Secondary/Senior Secondary schools as per the National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) to the students from class 9th to 12th. The scheme covers Government and Government aided schools. The state wise number of students who have opted for vocational education & training over last three years is at Annexure-II.
