Sanctioned vis-a-vis in position strength of teaching staff in Central Universities

669 Shri Imran Pratapgarhi:

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of sanctioned vis-a-vis in position strength of the teaching staff at the Central Universities across the country including Delhi University (DU);
- (b) the number of vacant posts filled in last one year in colleges/Departments of DU;
- (c) whether UGC norms are being followed while filling these vacancies; and
- (d) details of the Committee responsible for filling vacant posts in various colleges/departments of Delhi University?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (DR. SUBHAS SARKAR)

(a) to (d): As on 1st December 2022, the total number of sanctioned teaching posts in various Central Universities under the purview of Ministry of Education, including University of Delhi is 18956 out of which 12776 teaching posts are filled. The University of Delhi has filled 142 positions in the departments and more than 800 positions in the colleges in last one year. The teaching positions are filled as per the provisions of the Act and the Statutes of the University and the regulations of University Grants Commission (UGC) which includes Selection Committee for recommending the suitable candidates for the positions.
