#### **BUDGET OF THE MINISTRY**

715. Shri Derek O' Brien:

Will the Minister of MINORITY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- a. what has been the annual budget for the Ministry during last five years;
- b. what percentage of total budget is the total budget allocated to the Ministry, year-wise details for last five years;
- c. whether there has been a consistent fall in the allocation to this Ministry, and if so, the reasons therefor; and
- d. what is the amount of the Ministry's budget that is left unutilised at the end of each year during last five years?

### **ANSWER**

# THE MINISTER OF MINORITY AFFAIRS (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a), (b) & (d): The Government has implemented various schemes for the welfare and upliftment of every strata, including minorities, specially the economically weaker and lesser privileged sections of the society, through various schemes of the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Ministry of Textiles, Ministry of Culture, Ministry of women and Child Development and Ministry of Rural Development.
- 2. Ministry of Minority Affairs specifically implements various schemes across the country for socio- economic and educational empowerment of the six (6) centrally notified minority communities. The Schemes/ programmes implemented by the Ministry during the last five years are as under:

### A. Educational Empowerment schemes

- (1) Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme
- (2) Post-Matric Scholarship Scheme
- (3) Merit-cum-Means based Scholarship Scheme

## **B. Employment and Economic Empowerment Schemes**

As of present, there is a cumulative balance of Rs. 2520 crore (approx.) lying in State Nodal Agency (SNA) accounts of respective State/UT governments under PMJVK scheme and a large part of this is likely to be unspent even at the end of current financial year. Accordingly, BE for PMJVK has been reduced for the Financial Year 2023-24 to Rs. 600 crore, as against Rs. 1650 crore during the current Financial Year.
