GREEN MOTOR CORRIDORS DEVELOPED BY NHAI

722. DR. DHARMASTHALA VEERENDRA HEGGADE:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of Green Motor Corridors being developed by NHAI in the country;
- (b) whether NHAI is taking up 8005 KM long projects in Karnataka worth ₹ 2 lakh crore, if so, the details thereof:
- (c) the present status of Bharatmala-2 Project in Karnataka, project-wise;
- (d) the present status of laying two lanes with paved shoulders from Punjalakatte to Charmadi on Mangalore- Tumkur NH-73;
- (e) the CRF works sanctioned for the upgradation and improvements of roads and bridges in the State for last five years; and
- (f) the details of in-principle declared NHs in Karnataka during last five years?

ANSWER

- (a) At present, 27 Greenfield corridors having a total length of 9860 km are taken up under Bharatmala Pariyojana in the country. The details of the same are annexed.
- (b) A total of 103 number of projects for a length of 6290 km with a tentative cost of Rs. 1,63,867 crore have been envisaged by National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) in the State of Karnataka which are in various stages.
- (c) There is no approved Bharatmala-2 Project so far.
- (d) The work on the stretch from Punjalakatte to Charmadi on Mangalore Tumkur National Highway No. 73 has been awarded for construction.
- (e) There are a total of 315 number of works having a total cost of Rs. 2257.19 crore have been sanctioned under Central Road and Infrastructure Fund (CRIF) in the Financial Year (FY) 2017-18. No works have been sanctioned from FY 2018-19 to FY 2021-22.
- (f) A total of 88.2 km in-principle National Highways have been approved in the FY 2017-18. No in-principle National Highway has been approved from FY 2018-19 to FY 2021-22.
