DETAILS OF SHS CONVERTED INTO NHS

727. SHRI S. SELVAGANABATHY:

Will the Minister of **ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of State Highways (SHs) that have been converted into National Highways (NHs) in the country during the last five years and the current year in the country, State-wise including Puducherry;
- (b) the present status of ongoing upgradation of SHs into NHs in the said States; and
- (c) the target set for completion of the upgradation of SHs into NHs along with the details of funds allocated and spent on these projects in the said States?

(a) to (c) The Ministry keeps on receiving proposals from various State Governments / Union Territories (UTs) etc., including from the UT Government of Puducherry, for declaration / upgradation of State roads, including State Highways (SHs), as new National Highways (NHs). The Ministry considers declaration of some State roads, including SHs, as NHs from time to time based on the requirement of connectivity, inter-se priority and availability of funds.

State/UT-wise details of State Roads, including SHs, notified as NHs during the last five years and the current year are annexed.

The year-wise details of funds allocated and released/ expenditure incurred for development and maintenance of NHs during the last five years and the current year are as follows: -
