(d) to (f): The recruitment of teachers is a continuous process. The vacancies keep arising due to a number of factors including retirement of teachers and additional requirements on account of enhanced students' strength. Education is in the concurrent list of the Constitution. The recruitment, service conditions and deployment of teachers come under the purview of the respective State and Union Territory (UT) Government. The recruitment of teachers in schools is a continuous process and the vacancies keep arising due to retirement, resignation and additional requirements on account of enhanced students' strength/new schools. However, the Ministry of Education requests the State and UT Governments for filling-up the vacant posts of teachers and their rational deployment, through review meetings and advisories from time to time. Further, the Central Government through the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Samagra Shiksha, provides assistance to the States and UTs for maintaining appropriate Pupil-Teacher Ratio (PTR) as per the prescribed norms for various levels of schooling.
