CONSTRUCTION OF LAKES UNDER MISSION AMRIT SAROVAR AND MGNREG SCHEME

 - Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:
- (a) the number of lakes identified in different States of the country under Amrit Sarovar Mission in the MNREG scheme;
- (b) the number of lakes in which work has started and have been completed and the average capacity of the lake constructed in each State; and
- (c) details thereof in Gorakhpur district?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a) & (b) Mission Amrit Sarovar is aimed at developing/rejuvenating 75 water bodies in each district of the country as a part of celebration of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav. Each Amrit Sarovar will have pondage area of minimum of 1 acre with water holding capacity of about 10,000 cubic meter.

States/UTs-wise details of identified sites for Amrit Sarovar, number of sites on which work has been commenced and number of completed Amrit Sarovars are given at **Annexure.**

(c) A total of 313 sites have been identified for Amrit Sarovars in the Gorakhpur district of Uttar Pradesh and out of these identified sites, work has been commenced on 262 sites and 242 Amrit Sarovars have been completed.
