### **Status of the draft National Forest Policy**

# 844. SHRI SUJEET KUMAR:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Indian forests are currently governed by National Forest Policy (NFP) of 1988;

(b) whether the Ministry released a draft NFP in 2016, 2017 and a revised draft in 2019; and (c) the current status of the Draft National Forest Policy?

#### **ANSWER**

(a)to(c) Currently, the Indian Forestry is guided by the National Forest Policy, 1988. A draft National Forest Policy to update the existing policy has been prepared after wide stakeholder consultations. Based on suggestions and comments received from various stakeholders including State Governments/ UTs, Central Government Ministries/ Departments, initiatives have been taken to revise National Forest Policy.
