REGISTRATION ON ESHRAM PORTAL IN MAHARASHTRA

900. SHRI ANIL DESAI:

Will the Minister of Labour and Employment be pleased to state:

- (a)the nodal authorities responsible for the eShram Portal registration process at the State level and at the district level and the time by which the portal is likely to be opened for registrations;
- (b)the percentage of targeted number of registrations achieved till date, along with the district-wise details for Maharashtra;
- (c)the shortfall, if any, compared to the targeted number of registrations achieved till date, State-wise, along with the districtwise details for Maharashtra; and
- (d)the objective, criteria and basis on which the target number of registrations are decided for each State?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a): State Labour department is the nodal department for implementation of eShram in State. eShram portal was launched on 26th August 2021.

(b) & (c): As on 2nd February 2023, 1.34 crore unorganised workers have been registered on eShram portal against estimated target of 3.44 crore for the State of Maharashtra.

District wise number of unorganised workers registered on eShram, from State of Maharashtra is annexed.

(d): In order to mobilize unorganised workers for registration in the respective States/ UTs, they were provided with estimated target.

The target for registrations are based on Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) 2017-18.
