ESIC HOSPITAL AT KANPUR

901. SHRI ANIL DESAI:

Will the Minister of Labour and Employment be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the ESIC hospital at Kanpur has not become operational despite all the formalities relating to sanction of funds and equipment having been completed;**
- (b) the time by which the said ESIC hospital at Kanpur is likely to be operational for treating the patients; and**
- (c) the reasons for delay in making this hospital operational?**

(a) to (c): At present, there are five Employees' State Insurance (ESI) hospitals at Kanpur district of Uttar Pradesh one each at Jajmau, Azadnagar, Kidwainagar, Sarvodayanagar and Pandunagar in Kanpur. All these hospitals are operational.

Out of these five ESI hospitals, the hospital at Jajmau (Kanpur) is directly run by the ESI Corporation and the remaining four hospitals are run by the state government under the ESI Scheme (ESIS).
