#### MILLET PRODUCTION

#### 981. SHRI RAKESH SINHA:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the total estimated millet production in the country;
- (b) their distribution among the States and UTs;
- (c) the types of millets being produced in India; and
- (d) whether Government is considering to form a millets commission to examine its production and distribution and rationalise its use?

#### **ANSWER**

#### THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE

- (a) & (b): The State / UT-wise production of millets in the country for the year 2020-21 is given at **Annexure.**
- (c) and (d): The various types of millets cultivated in the country includes Sorghum (jowar), Pearl millet (bajra), Finger millet (ragi/mandua), Foxtail millet (kangni/Italian millet), Little millet (kutki), Kodo millet (Kodo), barnyard millet (sawan/jhangora), Proso millet (cheena/common millet) and Brown top millet (korale). The United Nation's General Assembly (UNGA) declared 2023 as International Year of Millets. Government of India has decided to celebrate IYOM-2023 to make it peoples' movement so that the Indian millets, recipes, value added products are accepted globally. In view of health benefits of the millets, the objectives are creating domestic & global demand of millets, focusing on strategies to enhance climate resilient Nutri-cereals production, consumption, export, branding etc.
