- a) whether Government plans to consider the declaration of the 64 ChausathiJogni Temple site in Bolangir district, Odisha State as a cultural World Heritage Site; and
- b) If so, the details thereof and the period by when such declaration shall be made, if not, the reason therefor?

(a) & (b) There is no such proposal under consideration for the 64 ChausathiJogni Temple site in Bolangir district, Odisha as a Cultural World Heritage Site. Inclusion of any site in the World Heritage List depends upon its Outstanding Universal Value, Authenticity and Integrity, and fulfillment of the criteria as defined in the UNESCO's Operational guidelines. Moreover, the proposed property must remain in the UNESCO's Tentative List for at least one year prior to submitting its nomination dossier. Currently, 64 ChausathiJogni Temple site is not included in the Tentative List.
