(a) to (d) Bharat Gaurav Tourist Circuit trains are aimed at experiencing India's rich cultural heritage and magnificent historical places by the people of India and the world. In the effort to achieve the objective, as of 24.07.2023, 75 trips of Bharat Gaurav trains have catered 36645 tourists/pilgrims on the different routes.

Bharat Gaurav Tourist Circuit trains have so far covered locations of historical and cultural importance across 23 States/Union Territories.

It is a continuous endeavor of Indian Railways to give a concerted thrust and facilitate operation of Bharat Gaurav Trains which has a multiplier impact on tourism potential and promotion in the country.
