- (b) if so, the status of the application and steps initiated by Government for establishing it; and
- (c) the details thereof?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF THE RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 140 RAISED BY SHRI JAGGESH, HON'BLE MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT ANSWERED ON 02/08/2023 REGARDING "KVS SCHOOL IN TUMAKURU, KARNATAKA".

(a) to (c) Opening of new Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) is a continuous process. KVs are opened primarily to cater to the educational needs of the wards of transferable Central Government Employees including Defence & Para-military personnel, Central Autonomous Bodies, Central Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and Central Institute of Higher Learning (IHL) by providing a common programme of education throughout the country. Proposals for opening of new KVs may be sponsored by Ministries or Departments of the Government of India / State Governments / Union Territories (UTs) Administrations, with commitment to provide requisite resources including land and temporary accommodation for setting up a new KV as per norms. The proposals are subject to approval of the competent authority.

As per information received from Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, no proposal for opening of a new KV near new helicopter factory at Gubbi, District Tumakuru, Karnataka has been received from the State Government of Karnataka. At present, 52 KVs are functioning in the State of Karnataka including 01 KV at Tumakuru.
