- (c) if so, whether investigations have been conducted in this regard to identify the individuals responsible, if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the Ministry has imposed any penalty on Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) or taken any action against its officials;
- (e) if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) if not, the reasons therefor?
