STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 215 FOR ANSWER ON 9 ${ }^{\text {TH }}$ AUGUST, 2023 ASKED BY DR. JOHN BRITTAS, HON'BLE MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT REGARDING VACANCIES IN CENTRAL UNIVERSITIES.
(a) \& (b) Occurring of vacancies and filling thereof is a continuous process. The vacancies arise due to retirement, resignation and additional requirements on account of enhanced students' strength. Central Universities have been directed to fill up vacancies as and when arising. The onus of filling up the posts lies on the Central Universities (CUs) which are autonomous bodies created under Acts of Parliament. As on 01.07.2023, the total number of sanctioned posts and vacancies in 45 Central Universities, running on regular mode under purview of Ministry of Education, are 54512 and 22412 respectively. Through special recruitment drive, 6087 posts have been filled up so far by the Central Universities as per the DoPT Mission Recruitment Portal.
(c) Total amount expended by Government for 45 Central Universities, running on regular mode under purview of Ministry of Education during last three years is as under:-
