Will the Minister of Petroleum and Natural Gas be pleased to state:

- (a) the list of States and UTs in the descending order of the prices of petrol along with prices in those States;
- (b) the list of States and UTs in the descending order of the prices of diesel along with prices of diesel in those States;
- (c) whether the State of Kerala has the highest prices of petrol and diesel in the country, and
- (d) list of States with petrol and diesel prices higher than Kerala?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

Statement referred to in reply to parts (a) to (d) in respect of Rajya Sabha Starred Question No. 40 for reply on 24.07.2023 regarding Prices of petrol and diesel asked by Dr. V. Sivadasan.

(a) to (d): Prices of petrol and diesel have been market-determined with effect from 26.06.2010 and 19.10.2014 respectively. Since then, the Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) take appropriate decision on pricing of petrol and diesel. Main components of petrol and diesel prices are Base Price, Excise Duty (levied by Centre Government), Value Added Tax (VAT) levied by State Governments and Dealer's Commission.
