**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PART (a) TO (d) OF RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 80\* FOR 27/07/2023 REGARDING “REGISTRATION ON E-SHRAM PORTAL” RAISED BY SHRI HARNATH SINGH YADAV**

**(a) to (d): Ministry of Labour & Employment launched eShram portal (eshram.gov.in) on 26th August 2021 for creation of a comprehensive National Database of Unorganised Workers verified and seeded with Aadhaar. eShram portal is meant to register and support the unorganised workers by providing them a Universal Account Number (UAN).**

**eShram portal provides multiple modes of registration, through self-registration as well as assisted mode registration to facilitate smooth registration process. Self-registration includes registration through eShram portal and Unified Mobile Application for New-age Governance (UMANG) mobile app. Assisted mode registration includes registration through Common Service Centres (CSC) and State Seva Kendras (SSKs).**

**As on 18<sup>th</sup> July 2023, over 28.96 crore unorganised workers have registered on eShram portal. Out of the above registrations, 47.23% workers are male and 52.77% workers are female.**
