SPAM CALLS FROM UNKNOWN INTERNATIONAL NUMBERS

Will the Minister of Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is aware that mobile users are getting missed WhatsApp calls from international numbers, particularly those who have registered themselves as business accounts;
- (b) whether Government is also aware that such calls are from fraudsters who are cheating people, in the name of earning through work-from-home;
- (c) whether Government has sent notice to WhatsApp to stop such spam calls; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by WhatsApp?

(a) to (d) To curb Unsolicited Commercial Communications (UCC) using Telecom resources provided by Telecom licensees, Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) issued Telecom Commercial Communication Customers Preference Regulation, 2018 (TCCCPR-2018). TRAI held meetings with Social Media platforms including WhatsApp for taking necessary steps to curb UCC through these platforms through collaborative approach.
